Dear Friends:

We are pleased to provide this first edition of our **now Biennial Report**, for 2009 and 2010, the 21st and 22nd years in our effort to promote better political journalism. A report every two years now replaces our previous annual reports.

At the conclusion of our 43rd class in December 2010, 525 college journalists had completed The Politics & Journalism Semester.

Thanks to the help of so many of you, thirty-eight more students received practical experience in Washington news bureaus in 2009 and 2010, from February to May and from September to December, while they were participating in our twice-weekly seminar series on campaign, governance and interest group politics.

See the complete reports on income and expenditures for the two years, plus financial statements and budgets, including a prospective budget for 2011. Note that we are facing major fundraising challenges because of the loss of two major donors in 2010, which reduced our 2010 revenue by one-half.

We continue to enjoy a broad base of support, with many institutional donors in both 2009 and 2010 and scores of checks provided by many individuals in politics and journalism.

I am especially pleased to report the ever-increasing support from our alumni. In 2009, 90 gifts from alums totaled \$9,315. **When we suffered our two major-donor losses last year, alumni stepped up and increased their support to \$17,688, from 153 gifts!**

And contributions from all individuals, including alumni and parents, totaled \$40,979 in 2010, compared to \$24,220 in 2009--**a seventy percent increase!**

Participating in the education of our 2009 and 2010 students, through our seminars, were over 60 volunteer speakers from both politics and journalism -- listed elsewhere in this report.

As always, this report gives you a complete listing of every single donation to the Center and every single expenditure, along with a simple, easy-to-read financial statement for each year. We feel that you deserve a detailed accounting of both the sources of our income and the exact nature of our expenses.

Due to a fund-raising shortfall, and in order to fully fund student stipends and other expenses of The Politics & Journalism Semester, the Center paid Michael only \$24,000 in 1989, \$26,500 in 1990, \$27,750 in 1991, and \$21,000 in 1992. Unpaid salary owed to Michael for 1989-92 totals \$90,750, which he has agreed to defer indefinitely. **SEP Shortfall:** In 2009, funds were insufficient to make a 10% of salary Simplified Employee Pension (SEP) contribution for Michael. He has also agreed to defer that indefinitely. (Reported here for documentation.)

Due to a fund-raising shortfall, and in order to fully fund student stipends and other expenses of The Politics & Journalism Semester, the Center paid Michael only \$24,000 in 1989, \$26,500 in 1990, \$27,750 in 1991, and \$21,000 in 1992. Unpaid salary owed to Michael for 1989-92 totals \$90,750, which he has agreed to defer indefinitely. **SEP and HSA Shortfalls:** In 2010, funds were insufficient to make a 10% of salary (\$13,200) Simplified Employee Pension (SEP) contribution for Michael and in 2010 funds were insufficient to make a \$4,000 contribution to Michael's Health Savings Account. He has agreed to defer both the SEP and HSA donations indefinitely. (Reported here for documentation.)
